Prague Castle



Built in the 9th century, Prague Castle is a UNESCO World Heritage site. This sightseeing tour takes you through the Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral, the old Royal Palace with Vladislav's Hall, Church of St. George, and the Golden Lane. You'll visit the Lobkowitz collection and attend a private concert.

DURATION: 4 hrs Tuesday / 7 hrs Thursday



Josefov Jewish Quarter



This synagogues and cemetery walking tour includes the story of Prague's Jewish community. The tour visits synagogues, the Old Jewish school, a unique Jewish clock, and a peaceful cemetery. You'll follow in Franz Kafka's footsteps and discover the places that influenced his writing.



Old Town with cruise



Discover Old Town Square with its dazzling array of buildings. The highlight of the Old Town Hall is its 15th century Astronomical Clock. Every hour, clockwork figures on the tower's facade enact a timely story. You'll also visit the Estates Theatre, where Mozart premiered "Don Giovanni." The tour ends at the river Vltava with a lovely cruise, providing a unique view of the city.

Explore places that are not usually a part of public tours. Hear stories, myths, and gossip as you visit hidden streets and houses in the Prague Castle area, stunning Strahov library, and Lesser Town with a beautiful hidden garden. The tour will end at John Lennon's wall. You'll finish the tour in a vintage car ride around the city.

Cooking lessons



Learn how to cook authentic Czech cuisine in a casual, friendly environment. The chefs will teach you how to prepare a bohemian fruit dumpling, potato soup, pancakes, and other snacks before you taste your creations. Please note that chefs may not be able to accommodate dietary restrictions, since meals are already planned.

This tour combines a walk through Old Town and New Town and visiting local shops. You'll be able to buy traditional Bohemian crystal (Preciosa, Moser), unique Czech garnet jewelry, natural cosmetic products (Manufaktura, Botanicus), and clothing by Czech fashion designers.

Design tour



Just steps away from the souvenir shops and big brand stores, you'll discover that Prague is home to a flourishing design scene with Czech-made products to suit every taste and budget. In recent years, entrepreneurial design graduates have been quietly building vibrant, diverse, and affordable alternatives to mainstream shopping, with boutiques, ateliers, and workshops. The most famous are Artel, Cihelna Concept Store, and Prague Cabinet.

Melnik Palace



Trek outside the city to visit a richly decorated palace that has become the residence of the queen widows of Bohemia. Under Emperor Charles IV, Melnik became a royal city. You'll visit the palace's private rooms and enjoy wine tasting in the cellars.

DURATION: 5 hrs Tuesday / 7 hrs Thursday

ACTIVITY LEVEL Easy to moderate

DESCRIPTION 1 hour transfer, short walk, 1 hour walk, wine tasting seated, return transfer



Nelahozeves Palace



Nelahozeves is one of Bohemia's most striking and monumental Renaissance palaces. It's splendidly decorated with sgraffiti, stucco, and frescos. You'll view private lodgings, royal rooms, and the music hall. You'll also see private collections of paintings, manuscripts, rare books, and weapons. You'll end with a wine tasting.

DURATION: 5 hrs Tuesday / 7 hours Thursday

Karlstejn Castle



The Karlstejn Castle was built in the 14th century by the Czech King and Roman Emperor Charles IV to hold the treasure of the Holy Roman Empire. After arriving in Karlstejn village, you'll take a horse-drawn carriage up the hill to the Castle. You'll explore the castle rooms and spend time shopping.

DURATION: 5.5 hrs Tuesday / 7 hours Thursday

ACTIVITY LEVEL moderate (many stairs)

DESCRIPTION 1 hour transfer, horse carriage 15 min., 90 min. castle visit, walk down to shopping, return transfer



Kutna Hora



The town of Kutna Hora, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is a medieval mining town. You'll visit the cathedral, Royal mint, and ossuary.

DURATION: 6.5 hrs Tuesday / 8 hours Thursday

Bohemian crystal



Established in 1846, Rückl moves traditional Czech glassmaking craft to a new level. You'll view each stage of crystal production, including the art of mouth blowing, delicate processes of quality control, the craftsmanship of glass cutting, and the painter's studio. You'll have time to shop in the crystal factory shop.

Pilsner brewery



Tour the Pilsner brewery and learn about the unique brewing process for Pilsner Urquell, the original Pilsner beer. During the tour, you'll move through the brew house via a labyrinth of storage cellars that have retained the traditional methods for producing beer. You'll also taste unfiltered beer.

DURATION: 5 hrs Tuesday / 7 hours Thursday

MAXIMUM GUESTS 135

SUGGESTED ATTIRE comfortable attire and walking shoes, please dress warmly as cellars are cold

MEALS Bottled water, unfiltered beer, (lunch on Thursday)

ACTIVITY LEVEL easy to moderate

DESCRIPTION 1 hour transfer, 2 hour visit, return transfer



Hike: Bohemian Paradise



Bohemian Paradise (Český ráj) is scattered with dramatic rock formations, deep shady valleys, meandering rivers, and quiet ponds surrounded by forests. Bohemian Paradise is a colorful mosaic of landscape types and historic monuments. You'll hike from Valdštejn castle through the Bohemian Paradise and end at Hrubá Skála Castle (approximately 3mi / 4.8km).

DURATION: 5 hrs Tuesday / 7 hours Thursday

Walk: Berounka river and St. John under the rock



See the beautiful countryside of Central Bohemia. After a short stop at Karlstejn, you'll land in a picturesque village where you'll admire the church with hermit cave St. John under the rock. You'll start the walk at the Berounka riverside bank (approximate 3mi / 4.8km). For those who want to continue, there is an extension for another 1mi / 1.6km that is a more involved hike.

ŠKODA car museum



ŠKODA is one of the world's oldest automotive brands. You'll visit the museum where you can see the original production halls in which the company manufactured cars until 1928. You'll learn about ŠKODA's history and admire the company's modern methods in a working manufacturing hall.

DURATION: 4.5 hrs Tuesday / 6 hours Thursday

Off-road Bohemia



Get behind the wheel of a 4x4 car and discover magnificent landscapes around Prague. The cars accommodate up to 4 passengers and a driver. You'll visit forgotten castles and local craftsmen, bivouac / barbecue for breakfast, a trek along narrow paths where only a 4x4 car would be able to take you.

DURATION: 4 hrs Tuesday / 6 hours Thursday

SUGGESTED ATTIRE comfortable attire and walking shoes

MEALS Bottled water, (lunch on Thursday)

ACTIVITY LEVEL easy to moderate. Unsuitable for those with motion sickness or certain physical conditions (due to significant jostling)

DESCRIPTION 1 hour transfer, short walk during the stop at Karlstejn, offroads (seated), and return transfer



Wake up, Prague!



Bonus excursion! This early morning stroll is offered to everyone as a welcome gift to Prague. Enjoy the history and architecture of the City of a Hundred Spires without the hustle and bustle of crowds. This 60-minute walk lets you explore the sites you wouldn't be able to see during during busier times.
